Malaysia's Roadmap Towards Zero Single Use Plastic 2018-2030





- Vision: <u>Towards zero single-use plastics for a</u> <u>cleaner and healthier environment in Malaysia by</u> <u>2030</u>
- Roadmap approved by Cabinet Ministers on <u>10th</u>
 October 2018;
- Launched <u>17th October 2018</u> in conjunction with IGEM.

"Single-use plastics - Plastics that are commonly used for plastic packaging, carry bags and include items <u>intended to be used only once before they are thrown away</u>"



Tax Incentive – 2019 Budget

Pioneer Status incentive of 70% or investment allowance of 60% for five years to be granted to companies which produces environmentally-friendly plastics based on bio-resins and bio-polymers.

Do not separate their plastic waste from normal rubbish




Burn/dispose of the plastic waste inside or outside their home/property




MALAYSIAN POLICY INITATIVES
