



Local Government Act 1976 which is:-




NO SINGLE-USE PLASTIC CAMPAIGN


- No Plastic Straw Approach



- To minimise the quantity of plastic straws that is harmful to the environment in a short term through awareness programs and campaigns.
- To abolish thoroughly the use of plastic straws in the long run through enforcement

- Food and beverage premises will no longer permitted to provide plastic straws in the room/corner/counter
- Plastic straws will only be provided to consumers upon request only
- Food and beverage premises are allowed and encouraged to use the substitutes items
