




### China

#### PLASTIC SCENARIO IN MALAYSIA

- Malaysia is now one of the main destination to bring in plastic as China has banned import of plastic into China.
- China's National Sword Policy 2018.
- Importation of plastic waste to China.
   Affecting global recycling activity.



#### **Plastic Straws**

Malaysians use up about 31 million plastic straws every day which is enough to fill up eight school buses per day, 57 per week and 2920 per year.

# CAMPAIGN NO SINGLE USE PLASTIC

Say No To Plastic Straw

After imposing a state-wide ban on plastic bags 10 years ago, the state government has decided to take the initiative one step further – no plastic bags for shoppers even if they are willing to pay 20 sen starting July 1 2019.



#### We Can Achieve

A survey conducted by the state government revealed 76 per cent support for the No Single Use Plastics campaign.

# We Lead – No Plastic bags since 2009

Thai - retailers just started 2020 with a ban on single-use plastic bags.

Indonesia - The regulation imposes a ban on single-use plastic bags in modern department stores and supermarkets, as well as traditional markets, and requires eco-friendly bags to be available in stores and markets.


# Our Biogas Pilot Plant at Batu Maung Transfer Station





#### **Batu Maung Transfer Station**

Recover the green waste and turn into biomass material with capacity at 50 tons per day



#### Food Waste-to-Energy :Circular Economy



- Reduced methane from landfill equivalent to 68,000 t CO2/year
- Reduced use of fossil fuel for electrical equivalent to 11,000 t CO2/year
- Reduced usage of inorganic fertilizer
- Reduction on CO<sub>2</sub> Emission (100t Food Waste/Day)


